SIHD's EVOLUTION

1980: Creation of the Public Establishment of Hydrocarbons (EPH) responsible for regulating the price of hydrocarbons in the country.

2000: Decree on the creation of the Limited company named International Hydrocarbon Company of Djibouti (SIHD) in which the State holds all the shares.

2000: Constitution of the articles of incorporation of the International Hydrocarbon Company of Djibouti (SIHD).

2013: appointment of the board of directors

2014: Building and maintaining emergency stocks of petroleum products

2015: International Hydrocarbon Company of Djibouti (SIHD) acquires the exclusive right to import refined hydrocarbons but also to build up a security stockpile refined hydrocarbons to ensure the country's security of supply in the event of a disruption.

ABOUT US

The history of the International Hydrocarbon Company of Djibouti (SIHD) dates back to the early 80's with the creation of a public regulator of the oil market in Djibouti. Mindful to the importance of the oil sector, the legislators created the Public Establishment of Hydrocarbons (EPH) on 14th July 1980 to regulate the price of hydrocarbons in the country.

Following the dissolution of the Public Establishment of Hydrocarbons (EPH) that was in charge of the stabilization and distribution of petroleum products and derivatives imported into Djibouti, the Djibouti Government created a public company on the 3rd of February 2000 to participate in the import and distribution of petroleum products for local consumption in the same manner as companies operating in the country.

SIHD is a public limited company with a capital of DJF 1,000,000,000 wholly owned by the State. The company has legal personality and management autonomy.

The International Hydrocarbon Company of Djibouti (SIHD) is an integrated petroleum company, which operates in Djibouti and intends to cover all the needs in petroleum products of the country. Its primary mission is to ensure the import of hydrocarbons and derivatives under the best price conditions in Djibouti, and to develop the national hydrocarbon sector.

SIDH is an environmentally responsible society, and its partners are certified in accordance with international standards.



MISSION AND OBJECTIVES OF SIHD

It is mainly importing, storing and exporting petroleum products not only in the Republic of Djibouti, but also in all the countries of the region.

The goal is to diversify across all segments of the oil business. In this sense, we plan to develop our activities upstream and downstream, starting with the refining of petroleum products, then storage and ending with marketing in the local market as well as export through the following benchmarks:

- Ensure the importation of hydrocarbons and derivatives under the best price conditions.
- To acquire interests in the industries of transformation of crude oil into finished products.
- Undertake the necessary research into the quality of petroleum products.
- Ensure storage of refined petroleum products (storage depot).
- Ensure fuel security in the Republic of Djibouti.
- Promote Djibouti as a centre for the redistribution of hydrocarbons and derivatives at the regional and international levels.

Regularly monitor and analyze the evolution of world petroleum product prices and the consequences on the national economy.

Negotiate and conclude agreements with all agencies to promote, in accordance with government policy, the development of the country's hydrocarbon sector.

To develop and operate the supply of petroleum products and derivatives from the refinery in all necessary sectors by concluding contracts with Prospect and undertake commercial operations with countries in the

Decrease the nation's energy dependency level through the diversification of potential energy sources in order to reduce the nation's energy bill.

Develop an appropriate strategy in the event of large fluctuations in oil price.
